COVID 19 – RISK ASSESSMENT

TRAINING VENUE

These pro-forma risk assessments have been produced following Government guidelines and are liable to change in the event of either easing or tightening of the lockdown restrictions.

HAZARD: Coronavirus (Covid-19)	
WHO MIGHT BE AFFECTED: Coaches or players could contract the virus and fall ill. Special consideration needs to be given to vulnerable participants with the classification extended to those with the most serious underlying health conditions as defined by Public Health England (PHE).	
CONTROL MEASURES	IN PLACE (YES / NO / NA)
<u>Venue Access – Coaches:</u> On arrival gloves are to be worn to open or close any locks, gates etc. Gates to the courts to be opened prior to arrival of participants to limit cross contamination.	
<u>Social Distancing:</u> Social distancing signage adequately displayed.	
<u>Sanitisation Station:</u> Sanitisation station set up in a location with either hand gel or wipes, with disposal in bin provided – all participants will be asked to sanitise before and after each session.	
<u>Personal Belongings:</u> Participant belongings/bag drop, following social distancing, clearly indicated around the courtside area – each participant to be advised prior to session which area they have been allocated.	
<u>Social Distancing on Court:</u> Participant on court position, following social distancing, clearly indicated on the court – each participant to be advised prior to session of procedure.	
<u>Equipment:</u> The use of shared equipment will be limited whenever possible and will be sanitised after each session.	
<u>Toilet Facilities - Available:</u> All participants will be advised following booking of a session if their chosen venue has toilet facilities, together with the access & hygiene arrangements.	
<u>Toilet Facilities -Not Available:</u> All participants will be advised following booking of a session that their chosen venue does not have toilet facilities.	
<u>Hydration:</u> All coaches and participants to be advised to practice healthy habits, including adequate hydration to keep mucous membranes moist.	

<p><u>Covid 19 Self-Reporting:</u> All coaches and participants advised before session and at the start of each session the importance of self-isolation should they show any symptoms of Covid-19 or if someone from their household is having so self-isolate.</p>	
<p><u>Spectators:</u> No spectators allowed to the session to limit potential spread of Covid-19 and to ensure social distancing can be maintained</p>	
<p><u>Timing of Sessions:</u> All participants advised to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before start time and to leave in a timely manner following the end of the session to ensure there is no possibility of cross over from the next session.</p>	
<p><u>First Aid:</u> There will be a designated First Aid station with clear signage, next to the sanitisation station to assist with hygiene procedures.</p>	
<p><u>Accident/Injury - Participants:</u> To bring to the session face mask and gloves in the event of an injury whereby should you need to be assessed treated by the designated First Aider these are can be worn to avoid possible infection due to close contact. These could also be required should another participant need to assist with moving injured party or driving a vehicle not belonging to them.</p>	
<p><u>Accident/Injury – Coach:</u> All coaches will be provided with face masks and gloves within their kit bag. In the event of an accident/injury coach to wear both before implementing First Aid procedures.</p>	
<p><u>Housekeeping:</u> At the start of each session the coach will read out the session housekeeping</p>	
<p><u>Player Procedures:</u> All participants will be issued with a copy of the player procedures upon booking their session. This will be issued at each booking (please refer to separate sheet for further information)</p>	
<p><u>Coaching Procedures:</u> All coaches to be qualified with First Aid Certification. Coaches will be briefed prior to the start of week 1, with regular updates as and when guidelines may change.</p>
