

DUDLEY ROAD HOSPITAL NETBALL CLUB

CLUB RULES

1. **Affiliation**

All players and umpires must be affiliated to the All England Netball Association.

2. **Fees Payable**

Each team member shall pay '*subs*' to be decided annually by the Committee. This can be paid either in a lump sum at the beginning of the season or by monthly instalments.

3. **Uniforms**

Full registered uniforms and bibs must be worn at each match. Skirts/dresses must be of uniform length and must cover the pants.

Jewellery & Nails

No items of jewellery to be worn and nails to be kept short.

Gloves & Hats

Gloves may not be worn unless medical evidence is submitted and only then, and must be of a suitable soft material. No peaked hats e.g. baseball caps. To be worn.

4. **Training**

Training will take place once per week. All participants will be expected to attend otherwise they will not be eligible to play in match games.

Punctuality

Participants continually failing to attend training/match games will forfeit the right to take part.

5. **Selection**

Selection for match games will be made by the coach. Only those participants who have attended training regularly will be eligible to take part in match games.

6. **Behaviour**

All participants will be expected to conduct themselves in a dignified and sportsmanlike manner, and to respect the rights of all other players, coaches, umpires, administrators and other personnel, and to play in the true spirit and within the rules of the game. The Committee will reserve the right to warn or suspend, any player who behaves in an unacceptable manner.

7. **Liabilities**

The Club accepts no responsibility for any losses sustained at any fixture arranged by the Club

The Club accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident caused before during or after, or as a result of any occurrence at any other fixture arranged by the Club.

8. **Health & Safety**

It is the responsibility of all users to ensure that they abide by the health and safety regulations laid down by the particular institution being used at that time.

9. **Fundraising**

The Committee, in conjunction with the Club's Fund Raiser, shall be responsible for organising at least one fund-raising activity per year.
